K-8 Summer School 2019

Glacier Edge will be the location for Elementary Summer School programming and **Savanna Oaks Middle School** will be the location for Middle School programming. Classes will range in size from 18 to 36 students, depending upon the number of instructors for each course.

Interested teachers have proposed courses that incorporate literacy, language, Math, problem solving and technology experiences in their offerings. These summer opportunities may also include time for drama, arts, hands-on investigations, and experiential learning. All courses will be offered by certified teachers at no cost to students, with the exception of a small materials fee for certain classes using significant materials. All fees will be waived for students receiving free/reduced lunch during the school year.

Sessions/Times

The 2019 Elementary/Middle Summer School session will run for 5 days/week for up to 3 weeks, from July 8th - July 26th, 2019 from 8:30-11:00 am.

Student Drop-off/Pick-up

All Elementary/Middle school students are to be dropped-off at the front entrance of Glacier Edge Elementary School or Savanna Oaks Middle School. Classes begin at 8:30 am; please do not drop your child off prior to 8:20 am. Classes end at 11:00 am. Please pick your child-up in the front of Glacier Edge Elementary School or Savanna Oaks Middle School at that time.

AP Language Boot Camp - Summer Assignment and Course Preparation

Instructor: Laura Jeidy-Brown

Dates: July 8-19, 2019

Grade: 9-11

Notice: Please only enroll your child if they are **CURRENTLY in grades 9, 10 or, 11**. Students registered by incorrect grade will automatically be disenrolled.

Description: During the first week of AP Language and Composition, all students are required to write an essay about "Walden and Civil Disobedience" by Henry David Thoreau. This classic text can, at times, be challenging. This enrichment summer course is designed to help support students as they enter AP Language and Composition and work through the summer assignment. As a class and individually, students will tackle the major elements of the summer assignment and analyze the potential essay questions. This course will also supplement students' understanding of key components of AP Language and Composition, which includes preparing students for rhetorical analysis.

Fee: Students will need to have purchased the book "Walden and Civil Disobedience" before this course begins. This is the required text for the course, and all students will have to buy this before the semester begins. If you require financial assistance, check in with the main office to obtain the book.

AP Psychology Boot Camp

Instructor: Sarah Domres

Dates: July 8-July 11 (Monday-Thursday), July 15-16 (Monday-Tuesday) * Only have to attend 4 days

Grade: 11

Notice: Please only enroll your child if they are **CURRENTLY in grade 11**. Students registered by incorrect grade will automatically be disenrolled.

Description: Anyone who is currently registered to take AP Psychology is encouraged to take this class. Students that attend will be able to start and finish their summer work as well as get it graded immediately. This will allow students to start off their AP class with a solid academic grade. Additionally, Ms. Domres will work with individual students on skills such as reading our college level text, proper note-taking, and best ways to study in AP Psychology. It will be fun, flexible, and productive. This summer, the camp is being offered over two weeks for 6 days. However, students only need to attend ANY FOUR DAYS. Additionally, students who attend the full four days will receive an extra credit grade boost during first semester. If you need more than four days to finish your summer assignment, you are welcome to attend all days that it is offered. An A+ will be held to provide more information prior to the end of the school year.

AP U.S. History Boot Camp (APUSH)

Dates: July 8 - August 2, 2019

Grade: 10-11

Notice: Please only enroll your child if they are **CURRENTLY in grades 10 or 11**. Students registered by incorrect grade will automatically be disenrolled.

Description: Anyone who is currently registered to take AP U.S. History (APUSH) is encouraged to take this class. Students will be introduced to the APUSH themes, practice historical thinking skills, develop writing skills, and have an opportunity to work on and complete the summer assignment. This class is especially encouraged if this is your first AP class and/or your first history AP class; it will also be beneficial for those students who want an introduction to APUSH concepts and need more opportunities to develop their writing skills. The camp is being offered over two weeks for 6 days. However, students only need to attend ANY FOUR DAYS. Additionally, students who attend four days will receive an extra credit grade boost during first semester. Students are more than welcome to attend all eight days – each day will be focusing on a specific component of the course – historical thinking skills, writing skills, and the APUSH themes – these will be shared with the students at an A+ session at the end of the school year so students can plan accordingly.

Chemistry Prep for Success

Dates: July 22 - August 2, 2019 - **PLEASE NOTE THE DATE**

Grade: 8-11

Notice: Please only enroll your child if they are **CURRENTLY in grades 8, 9, 10, or 11**. Students registered by incorrect grade will automatically be disenrolled.

Description: This two-week session will focus on attaining some of the skills that will build confidence in the learner who is already enrolled in general chemistry for the upcoming school year. Some of the skills that students will acquire in this session include: metric conversions, naming and writing compound formulas, balancing equations, types of chemical reactions, and an introduction to the process of dimensional analysis. Each day will include a laboratory activity to help participants implement the skills they are taught.

Advanced Algebra - ONLINE

Instructor: Laura Bakken

Dates: July 8-August 2, 2019

Grade: 8-11

Notice: Please only enroll your child if they are **CURRENTLY in grades 8, 9, 10, or 11**. Students registered by incorrect grade will automatically be disenrolled.

Description: This is an ONLINE course. Students will have an option to come in and work with the instructor if desired. Students who have successfully taken the first semester of Advanced Algebra and who want to take PreCalculus or College Algebra in the Fall are encouraged to enroll. Students who want to refine their Advanced Algebra skills are also encouraged to enroll. Learning can start early "unofficially" in June with built-in formative assessments. Summative assessment will need to be taken on-site with the instructor. The topics of this course include trigonometry, exponentials, logarithms, sequences, series, rational functions, and rational equations. Students who sign-up will be requested for an A+ session in early June where the online format and flexible due dates will be clearly explained.

Geometry B

Grade: 9-12

Notice: Please only enroll your child if they are **CURRENTLY in grades 9, 10, 11, or 12**. Students registered by incorrect grade will automatically be disenrolled.

Description: Geometry B is the second semester of a traditional year-long high school Geometry class. The topics of this course include but are not limited to area and perimeter of polygons, circles and composite figures, angles and chords in circles, arc length and area of sectors, volume and surface area of 3-dimensional shapes, special right triangles, and right triangle trigonometry

Introduction to Psychology - ONLINE

Dates: July 8-August 2, 2019

Grade: 10-11

Notice: Please only enroll your child if they are **CURRENTLY in grades 10 or 11**. Students registered by incorrect grade will automatically be disenrolled.

Description: This is an ONLINE course, which will introduce students to several essential topics in the study of psychology including: Approaches & Methodology, Neuroscience Basics, Psychological Disorders, Sensation & Perception, and Theories of Development. This is an excellent prep course for students that plan to take AP Psych senior year. It will pre-teach some of the concepts that students tend to struggle with. This is also a great option for those students who are interested in psychology, but don't have time for or interest taking it at the Advanced Placement level. Students who sign up will be requested for an A+ session where the online format will be clearly explained. The course will run over 4 weeks with 4 turn in deadlines for work. Teacher(s) will be available for in-person help & questions one day a week; if a student's grade is below a 60%, they will be required to attend summer school on the assigned day for drop-in help.

Health - Two Sections

Dates: July 8-August 2, 2019

Grade: 10-12

Notice: Please only enroll your child if they are **GOING TO BE in grades 10, 11, or 12**. Students registered by incorrect grade will automatically be disenrolled.

Description: Blended Health Education covers the exact same information as Health Education, however part of the course is designed to be completed online via Canvas. The online portion of this class will help to further technology skills and serve as preparation for future high school and college classes that have similar requirements. This is a .5 credit course that is required for graduation. We will meet select days from 8 am to noon. Students MUST be present for the in-class days in order to receive credit, no exceptions! Meeting dates: July 8, 9, 10, 11, 16, 17, 18, 22, 24, 26, 29, 31 and August 1, 2

*** If too many students sign up, there will be a selection process by grade level first. Rising 12th graders will have first priority, rising 11th graders next priority, and rising 10th graders as last priority. If it comes to a tie of students, whomever registered first would get priority. Final decisions on enrollment will not be made until mid-June. You will receive an email if your student is enrolled or not.***

Managing Your Financial Life

Grade: 9-11

Notice: Please only enroll your child if they are **CURRENTLY in grades 9, 10, or 11**. Students registered by incorrect grade will automatically be disenrolled.

Description: This course explores a range of strategies for growing a small amount of wealth into a much larger amount of wealth. A variety of methods for starting this process of wealth creation – with the largest emphasis placed on the stock market – are examined. In addition, other investments such as real estate, bonds, mutual funds, and retirement funds are embedded into course projects. After completing this course, students will be in a better position to assist others with financial issues. This course may count for .5 math credit toward high school graduation, as long as a student completes 2.0 credits in the math department. Postsecondary institutions and NCAA may not recognize this class for math credit.

Notice: Please only enroll your child if they are **CURRENTLY in grades 9, 10, or 11**. Students registered by incorrect grade will automatically be disenrolled.

Description: This summer school PE course will offer students a chance to be active during the summer! Activities will be chosen by staff and student interest. There will be activity and academic components to this course. Successful completion of this course will satisfy .5 credit of PE towards graduation and DPI requirement. Students **MUST** be in attendance for all 4 hours, all 4 weeks in order to receive credit.

Reel History: U.S. History Through Film - ONLINE

Instructor: Julie Berndt

Dates: July 8-August 2, 2019

Grade: 9-11

Notice: Please only enroll your child if they are **CURRENTLY in grades 9, 10, or 11**. Students registered by incorrect grade will automatically be disenrolled.

Description: This is an ONLINE course, which offers students a unique way to understand U.S. history through films and will enhance your knowledge of significant events in United States history. With each film, students will examine the significance of the time period through primary and secondary sources and analyze the accuracy of the film in representing U.S. history. We will look at the context in which the film was made and analyze various perspectives and biases. A signed permission slip will be required to view the films. Films used in previous courses include The Patriot, Glory, and Dances with Wolves. Students who sign up will be requested for an A+ session where the online format will be clearly explained. The course will run over 4 weeks with 4 turn in deadlines for work. Teacher(s) will be available for in-person help & questions one day a week; if a student's grade is below a 60%, they will be required to attend summer school on the assigned day for drop-in help.

Seeds of Change Summer Research

Instructor: Angie Midthun-Hensen

Dates: July 8-August 2, 2019

Grade: 9-12

Notice: Please only enroll your child if they are **CURRENTLY in grades 9, 10, 11, or 12**. Students registered by incorrect grade will automatically be disenrolled.

Description: Students will travel to Costa Rica to complete research on the leaf cutter ant and sea turtles through the cooperation of UW Madison Curry labs and The University of Costa Rica. Dr. Adrian Pinto and his graduate students lead the research in Costa Rica. The students are responsible for completing pre-trip curriculum in the months preceding the research experience. While in Costa Rica they are involved in field research, lab experiments, community service projects with the local village and turtle population studies. The pre-trip curriculum is rigorous and engaging. While on the research trip, the students put in 6-12 hours each day on their projects, learn how to conduct fair research, and how to statistically analyze their results. After the trip the students have a poster symposium where they present their research.

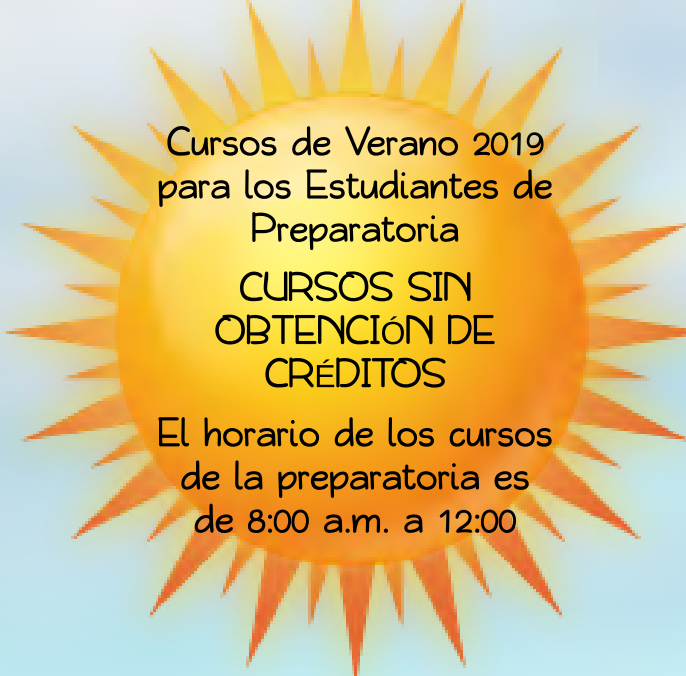

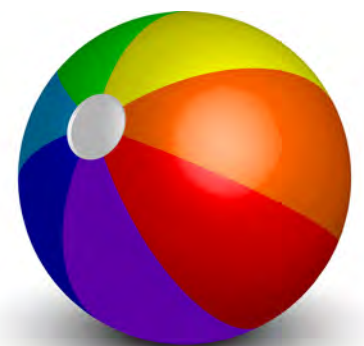
